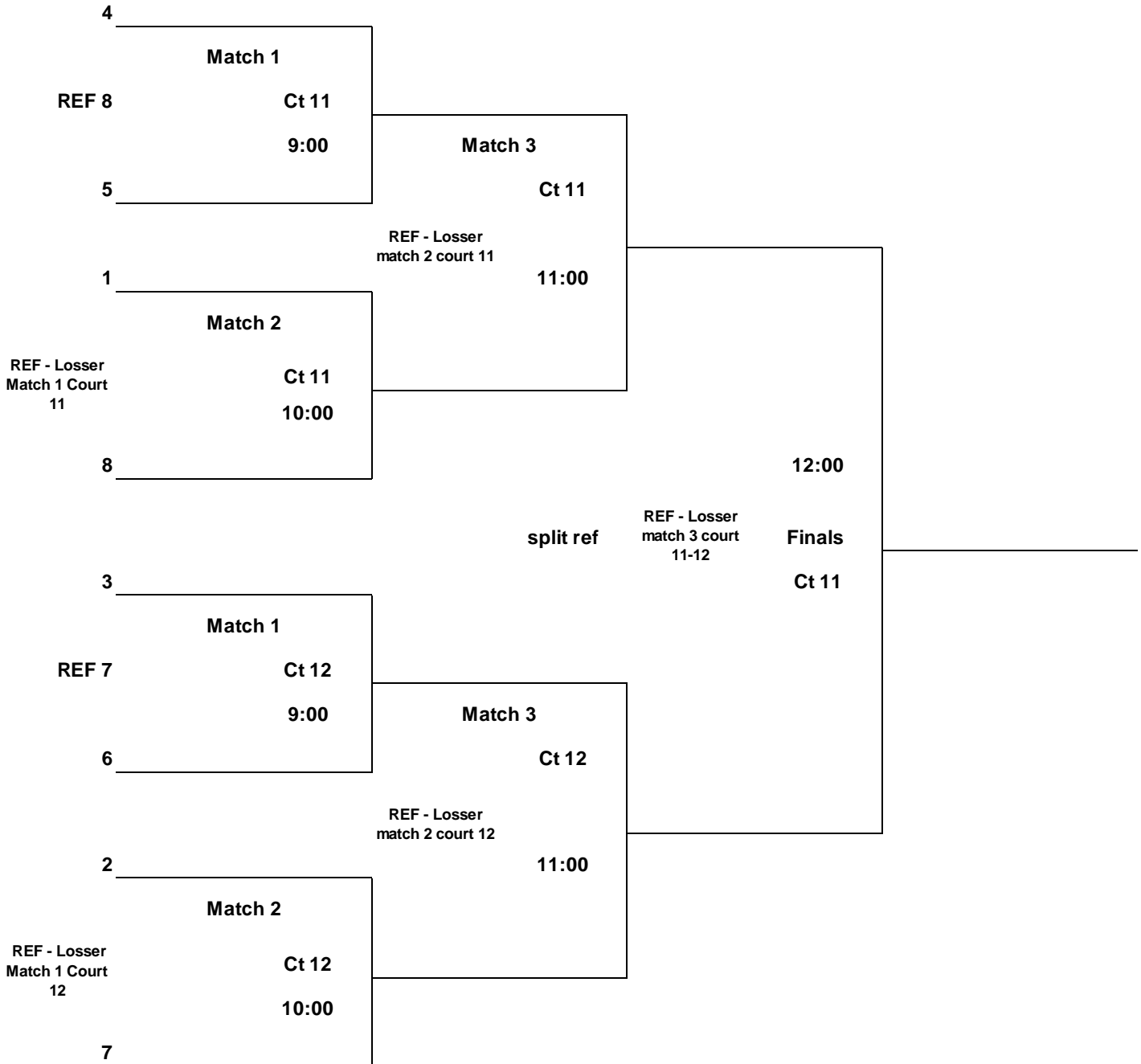

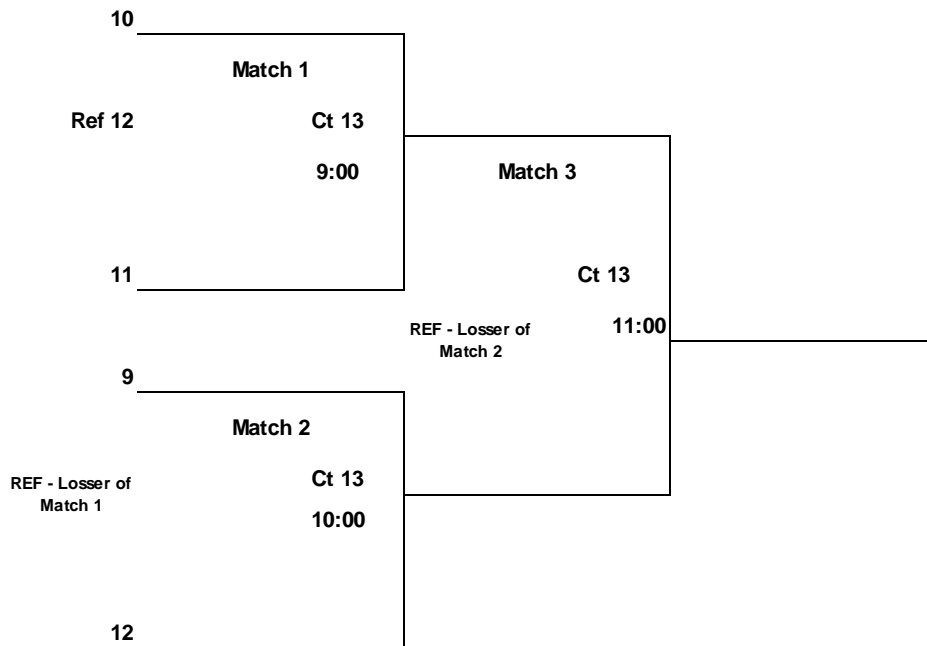

RULES FOR THE CEDAR VALLEY CLASSIC VOLLEBALL TOURNAMENT

1. On Sat. play will begin at 8:00 AM
2. On Sunday play will begin at 9:00 AM
3. Saturday play will be pool play and teams will be seeded to determine play on Sunday.
4. Top 8 teams in each age group will go to championship play and the remaining teams will move to the consolation bracket.
5. Medals (12/team) will be given to the 1st and 2nd place team in the championship bracket for each age group.
6. It is the responsibility of each coach to make sure their team is on time. If you are 5 minutes past game time you will not be allowed a warm up and you will forfeit the first game of the match – if you are later than 15 minutes you will forfeit the match.
7. All games need to begin on time and it is the responsibility of the officiating team to make sure this happens.
8. Warm ups – will be as follows for the first match played for the day per team - 2-4-4 warm-up procedure. Teams will have shared warm-up for 2 minutes, followed by 4 minutes alone on the court for each team. Serving must take place within that 4 minute period. The captains meeting and coin toss should take place during the first 2 minutes, and the first 4 minutes should begin immediately following the coin toss. The following matches will have a 5 minute shared warm up time.
9. Each team will have to officiate throughout the tournament – if a officiating team is not there on time they will forfeit the first game of their next match – if the officiating team

does not show up to ref they will forfeit the entire next match.

10. Criteria for team seeding –
 - a. Win loss record
 - b. Points differential
 - c. Head to head
11. If teams tied for a playoff position –
 - a. Head to head win loss record
 - b. Points from head to head play
 - c. Coin toss
12. If two teams are tied for one spot in the championship bracket there will be a one game playoff to 25 – the winning team will move to championship bracket and the losing team will move to consolation bracket.
13. If 3 teams are tied for 2 championship positions the team with the highest point spread will be given a position and the remaining 2 teams will have a one game playoff.
14. Depending on the number of teams in each age group the Sat. pools will consist of either 4 team pools or 7 team pools – every team will play 6 games on Sat.
15. Sunday play Championship and Consolation brackets are single elimination with the losing team officiating the next game.
16. Again NO COOLERS will be allowed...
